2009 Summer Programs Teaching Assistant

Up to four Summer Programs teaching assistantships are available for each term (May term: May 18 – May 29, First Session: June 1 – July 3, Second Session: July 6 - August 7, on the campus of the **Dauphin Island Sea Lab**. Assistantships are available for one or more of the terms to qualified applicants. Course listings are available at the address below or visit our web site at: <http://www.disl.org>.

Qualifications/Restrictions:

- Assistants will generally need to be in residence at the Sea Lab one week before their assignment begins for orientation and to assist with course set-up. Assistants must also be able to complete a laboratory inventory and store teaching materials after classes end.
- Graduate student status is desired (junior/senior undergraduates may be considered, if qualified).
- Assistants must have academic training in at least one of the following areas: ecology, marine biology, marine botany, marine vertebrate zoology, marine invertebrate zoology or oceanography; field experience is strongly preferred. It is also desired that the assistant has successfully completed the course for which they are assisting.
- Assistants may not be enrolled in classes due to time commitment and scheduling problems.
- Assistants may be required to work on weekends or go on overnight trips.
- Assistants must be CPR certified.

Responsibilities:

- Work on average 20 hours per week assisting professor in preparation of field and laboratory exercises.
- Instruction of students in the laboratory and some laboratory lecturing may be required.
- Participation in field exercises and specimen identification is required.
- Keep laboratory supplied, organized, and clean.

Compensation:

- A stipend will be provided at the current graduate student rate (\$261 - \$327 per week) depending on graduate status. If undergraduate, rate will be different.

Application:

- A complete application must include the following documentation: (1) A letter of interest indicating the specific course(s) you can assist with and the session(s) that you are available, (2) a transcript itemizing your training and experience in the subject area(s), (3) a letter of recommendation from a faculty member who can evaluate your qualifications and previous teaching performance, and (4) a completed application form.

DEADLINE:

- Review of applications will begin on February 13 and will be completed when all positions are filled.
- Applications will be reviewed and selections made by the Chair of University Programs and/or course instructors.
